

PRIVACY POLICY

Responsible for the processing of personal data:

RYBONE is responsible for the processing of your personal data, whether automated or not, from collection, organization and conservation till its disposal.

RYBONE knows and complies with the rules provided for the processing of personal data, which are currently provided for in Regulation (EU) 2016/679, of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016.

Finality

Your data will not be passed on to others, nor will it be used for purposes other than those for which you gave us consent.

Please note that the communication of your personal data to RYBONE is not mandatory by law or for any other reason. Therefore, you are not obliged to provide us with your data, but if you do not do so, the consequence will be that you will not receive marketing for products and services marketed by RYBONE.

In addition, RYBONE, the entity to which consent is given for processing data or for sharing data, may hire service providers to carry out tasks for which consent has been given. Such service providers act as subcontractors, who are obliged to implement the appropriate technical and organizational measures to guarantee the privacy and security of your personal data. Updates may be shared between these entities.

Period of conservation of data

Your data will be kept for a period of 2 years from the granting of this consent or, if you have entered into a purchase or service agreement with us, for a period of 5 years from the granting of this consent, or for a longer period if the law so establish it.

Right of access, rectification, deletion, limitation of processing, opposing processing, requesting the portability of your data:

You have the right, whenever you want and free of charge, to ask RYBONE to:

- Access the data you have given us
- Ask for rectification of your data
- Ask for the deletion of your data
- Ask to limit the processing of your data
- Oppose the processing of your data
- Request the portability of your data to the entity indicated by you.

Note, however, that if there is a rule or legally imposed obligation that overrides these rights, RYBONE will respond to the impossibility of executing the request, indicating the respective grounds.

Right to complain

If you believe that your data is not being processed in accordance with the applicable legislation, namely European and national, we remind you that you have the right to complain to a supervisory authority (eg, National Data Protection Commission).
